Pray in the shower and feel even more refreshed when you are finished.

Pray through the commercials of your favorite TV Show. You'll have enough time to pray for five minutes AND still get something to drink!

Pray while you are stopped at a red light, pumping gas, standing in the grocery line...OH! How about praying while waiting at the license bureau? You can pray your way to world peace in that amount of time!!!

Pray anywhere, anytime! We have supplied you with pray ideas for each day including a place to write your own thoughts. You will find requests for Genesis Church, our community, nation, cultural concerns, missionaries and upcoming special events, to name a few. I encourage you to pray 'out of the box'. Prayer is an amazing midday pick me up with out the excessive amounts of caffeine man made remedies carry. So, save five bucks a day and join us as we Pray Our Way thru May!

During each day, we will provide you with a Scripture on which to meditate, and a format using the acrostic "PRAY" for your prayer time.

- Praise We will give you some ways to express your praise and adoration for God.
- **R**epent Our daily prayer life ought to include confession and honesty with God about our struggles and sin.
- Ask Each day we will give you three issues to include in your prayer for the day. One will be personal, for you. The second will involve issues of community, evangelism, culture, and other thing we should pray for, according to the Scriptures. The third will involve a prayer need for our church.
- Yield The last portion in our prayers each day will be a statement about how we can surrender our lives to God and His will in a deeper way.

Our hopes is that spending the thirty-one days praying will drive this spiritual discipline deep into your life, and that you will grow in your walk with Jesus.

Friday, May 1

Mark 10:27

"With God all things are possible."

Praise God for allowing you to live in a country where you have the opportunity to worship freely without the chance of death from a government whose views are different than yours.

Repent for any adverse thoughts you have had that would be dishonoring to Our Savior. Ask for His forgiveness so that you may work with a clear mind so that even your thoughts will glorify him.

Repent for any stinginess you may experience where tithing and giving to others come in.

Monday, May 4

Proverbs 14:21

Whoever despises his neighbor is a sinner, but blessed is he who is generous to the poor

Praise God for lifting up missions we can be a part of...within our church, Eureka, the state of Missouri, Haiti, South Africa and beyond!

Repent for not being more focused on helping others.

- ★ The young mother needing an extra hand in the grocery line.

- ★ The child next door that does not have a winter coat.

Ask - pray for:

- God to bless these situations and to help you gain knowledge as to which of these you need to become involved with.

- Genesis Ministry Teams those serving each Sunday

Yield -you- completely...your time, money, efforts, prayers. Step it up a notch and feel the happiness that helping brings if you do it in the right spirit...the spirit of God!

Tuesday, May 5...National Teacher Day

Deuteronomy 1:15

So I took the heads of your tribes, wise and experienced men, and set them as heads over you, commanders of thousands, commanders of hundreds, commanders of fifties, commanders of tens, and officers, throughout your tribes.

Praise God for those who have taught you through life.

Repent for the times you did not obey those who were placed in your life as a teacher...your parents, that cranky 5th grade teacher who always picked on you, the policeman who gave you a ticket in a 55 when you were zooming a cool 65...

Ask - pray for:

- Wisdom to listen to teachers in your life
- Those teaching in the schools around Rockwood by name if you know teachers personally
- Genesis partnership with Blevins Elementary

Yield you pride, yearn for the grace and mercy of God and the information He has tried to share with you that you overlooked or snubbed. Allow Him to teach you of His love through the leaders of Genesis.

Wednesday, May 6

1 Corinthians 14:15

What am I to do? I will pray with my spirit, but I will pray with my mind also; I will sing praise with my spirit, but I will sing with my mind also.

Praise God...thank Him, love Him, honor Him and sing His name. Think of all the wonderful words you have heard in the past that declares His greatness.

Repent today for the things heaviest on your heart when it comes to avoiding opportunities to pray and rejoice.

Ask - Pray for:

- Missionaries to Europe
- Nick and the Genesis worship bands

Yield your voice to God, be it in singing, praying or speaking His name. May you be so blessed as to have every word out of your mouth be pleasing to the LORD.

Thursday, May 7...National Day Of Prayer

Consider attending the National Day of Prayer service at the Eureka City Hall building, noon today.

Genesis 22:18

Yield to God and ask him to help make a mends if you are separated from anyone in your family. No matter whose fault or what the reason, use today to begin healing.

Monday, May 11

Deuteronomy 12:20

Repent of any ill feelings towards your fellow man, your neighbor who plays loud music at 1:30 am and the guy who cut you off in traffic yesterday.

- Unity in our church

Yield your understanding of others to God as He helps you see more than one side of a person's life and behaviors.

Tuesday, May 12

Joshua 1: 8

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

Praise God for giving you His Word to read, that you can use it to make educated choices in your life, so that you can feel the passion of the Holy Spirit as you read it.

Repent for not spending as much time reading the Bible, as you should...for not taking a few minutes every day to relish in His love for you.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to place the desire for more and for wisdom as you read. Ask that He allow your children to be touched and encouraged as they watch you reading through the scriptures.

Wednesday, May 13

Revelations 2:19

Praise God for being so incredibly loving towards us! Flatten yourself before HIM as we are so totally miserable and He is so overflowing with mercy and grace...He just keeps loving you.

Repent of the ridiculous and obtuse behaviors in your life. Write your sins in red! He sees all we cannot hide the least of sin from God.

Ask - Pray for:

- ...no, Plead to be exonerated of the times your actions were not glorifying to Our Lord and Master. Invite the Holy Spirit to lead your way.
- those living in poverty in our community and nation
- That Genesis would become a church founded on deep prayer

Yield to His judgment as He showers you with mercy and grace.

Thursday, May 14

Proverbs 4: 14-15

14: Do not enter the path of the wicked, and do not walk in the way of evil. 15: Avoid it, do not travel on it; turn away from it and pass on

Praise God for being a merciful God. Thank Him for the trouble He has kept you out of without you even knowing about it! Thank Him for giving you a manual, a road map of life...the Word!

Repent for the "evil doings" of your life. The teeny-tiny things that may not have been so big, but were still wrong...defiantly the whoppers!

Ask - Pray for:

- Endurance when you are suffering or persecuted by others
- Those in prison, as well as people who are seeking to minister to those who are in prison
- Genesis Elder Bob Lancaster

Yield your prayers today to those who are in jail that God will enter their hearts and they will accept the Gospel and be set free of their crimes.

Friday, May 15

Psalm 122:6

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem!" May they be secure who love you!

Praise God, Our Creator, Our King for loving the world in such an inconceivable manner.

Repent of the harsh feeling you have felt over your lifetime where war and conflict are concerned...at home, in Eureka all the way to Jerusalem. Be bold in you humbling so that your heart may be softened.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to not let worldly matters cause your focus on Him to stray.
- The peace and well-being of our city and nation
- For those going on Genesis mission trips to Haiti and Charleston, MO this Summer

Yield yourself today that God may use you to brighten the life of those you come in contact with. One person at a time, one neighbor hood at a time, one state, one country, one continent, one world. Be square one.

Saturday, May 16-GENESIS Prayer Breakfast At Heritage Presbyterian on Alt RD 9:30-10:30 AM. Please plan to attend!

Isaiah 45:20

"Assemble yourselves and come; draw near together, you survivors of the nations! They have no knowledge who carry about their wooden idols, and keep on praying to a god that cannot save.

Praise God for being a God who listens when we humble ourselves to Him and praise His majesty...God who loves us so much that He gave His only son to death so that He may rise and free us of our sins.

Repent of the times you have overlooked His offering you a chance to gather with your family of brothers and sisters in order to speak to Him.

Ask - Pray for:

- God enter your heart and help you understand the importance and glory in praying together as a church. Ask that your desires not override His direction.
- Others serving in our state government Senators, Representatives, judges, etc.
- Our Prayer Breakfast this morning.

Yield your time to His glory, His will.

Sunday, May 17

Matthew 28:19

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

John 17:25

O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me.

Praise God for trusting you to be His disciple. Love on Him, Honor Him, Glorify Him...

Repent of wasted moments.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to allow a mission to cross your path...knocking you in the head if it must. Ask God to give you a way to demonstrate your faith by showing kindness to another or serving those who are hurting.
- Missionaries in South America
- That we as a church would keep Jesus and the Gospel central in everything we do

Yield the lives of your children to the eternal plan of God.

Monday, May 18

James 5:16

Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

Praise God for being in your life. Pour out your love and appreciation to the Lord. Let Him know how deeply your life has changed since you became friends. Promise Him your undying love.

Repent of not spending enough time with fellow Christians and being there for those who may need you.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to give you a desire to do life and faith with other Christians
- Those in law enforcement
- Our Community Group ministry and the leaders

Yield to God by being sure you are prioritizing your family over other things in life such as job, entertainment, and hobbies.

Tuesday, May 19

Genesis 24:12

Then he prayed, "O LORD, God of my master Abraham, give me success today, and show kindness to my master Abraham.

Praise God that you either have a job or praise Him that you had a job and are willing to serve Him in any prospective job He brings to you.

Repent of your grumbling and frustrations in the past of your boss, fellow employees, the water cooler being empty or the one bathroom in a facility for 100 being occupied when you really need it.

Ask - Pray for:

- God for guidance in helping your disposition be a joyful one at work no matter what the day brings and that your reactions are honoring to God.
- Your spouse or if you are single, the one God has as a future spouse
- The preaching ministry at Genesis for Mike in his preparation and deliverance of messages to the church

Yield to God to be a help to your employer vs. a hindrance. Ask that as you continue to pray for God's will that you and your employer succeed so that jobs continue and other positions open up for those who are out of work.

Wednesday, May 20

Jonah 2;2

"I called out to the LORD, out of my distress, and he answered me; out of the belly of Sheol I cried, and you heard my voice.

Praise God for the many situations He has helped you out of. Thank Him for being with you and saving you each time you felt you were being eaten alive.

Repent for the times that your faith was low and you wallowed in self-pity. Plea forgiveness for the times you took matters into your own hands.

Ask- Pray for:

- God to give your soul peace in knowing that He is all mighty. Request that He nudge you and help you remember that He is always there waiting for you to come to Him.
- Those in city government in Eureka
- Genesis Elder John Parke

Yield to Him, in all things, all the time! He is merciful!

Thursday, May 21

Romans 8:26-28

26 Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. 27 And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God. 28 And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

Praise God for listening to you when you cry out to Him...when so distraught you don't even know where to begin.

Repent for times you didn't have enough faith to relinquish your difficulties to Him.

Ask - Pray for:

- your fears be settled in knowing the Holy Spirit is always with you. Ask for a rainbow...the colors create tranquility for your eyes as the Holy Spirit showers your heart with peace.
- Those serving in our military, especially those in harms way
- Upcoming projects in our community

Yield your confusions and frustrations. Allow God to mold them into trust and faith.

Friday, May 22

Matthew 18:21-22

21 Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" 22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven.

Praise The Lord for giving you chances over and over and over and you continually fight sin in your life.

Repent for the times that you had adverse feelings towards others, including anger, resentment, and unforgiveness.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to help you see areas in your life where you are slow to love and forgive others.
- Crosspointe Church in Bevo neighborhood the church we are helping to plant in the city of St. Louis
- Genesis Church to be a place where everyone feels welcome.

Yield your temptations to flare to God. Listen to Him when he puts that feeling of "Now, do you really want to do that" inside your head.

Saturday, May 23

Luke 12: 22-25

And he said to his disciples, "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on. For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing. Consider the ravens: they neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse nor barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds! And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life?

Praise God and tell Him how much you love Him. Thank Him for meeting all your needs. Relish in him glory for a couple of minutes.

Repent for the times you have no patience and take things into your own hands.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to give you the spirit of peace to wait on His timing and be able to accept His will over your own.
- People who live in your neighborhood who are disconnected from God
- Genesis to have a passion for the lost and hurting in our culture.

Yield everything to Him...even turning 50!

Sunday, May 24

Genesis 2:2

And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done.

Praise God that singing to His glory is not work so we don't take off Sundays from that! Thank Him for giving you another day to come together with 2 or more and worship Him.

Repent of the days you haven't taken time to call upon His name....the days you skipped worship to sleep in, the days there was something much more appealing to the mortal eyes than exalting the name of The Lord.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to alleviate the barriers that cause you to not be closer to Him each day of your life. Let Him hear your sincerity...
- The salvation of family members, including your kids
- Genesis to be a safe place for people to explore issues of faith, especially those who do not have a background in church

Yield the other things in life that have become so important to you.

- Baseball game (Cardinal to Little League)
- Laying in Bed watching TV
- Going to an early brunch
- Fishing, shopping, bar-b-quing...blah, blah, blah!

Monday, May 25...Memorial Day and EHS Graduation

Psalm 119:11

I have stored up your word in my heart: that I might not sin against you.

Praise God for allowing our Military and our Students to get as far as they have on their missions safely. Thank Him for watching over them as they both enter the battlefield.

Repent for any fear you feel and for not allowing God to be in total control of your future.

Pray for:

- the desire and ability to memorize the Scriptures.
- those who are graduating from high school and college as they begin the next phase of life.
- The wives and families of Genesis Elders

Yield your concerns as you lay them at the feet of Jesus. Trust Him to protect your loved ones.

Tuesday, May 26

Exodus 22: 22-23

²²You shall not mistreat any widow or fatherless child. ²³If you do mistreat them, and they cry out to me, I will surely hear their cry,

Praise God for your family, your health, your life! Thank Him for your spouse, parents and your children.

Repent of idolatry and materialism in your life.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to fill you with compassion and desire where these hurting souls fit into the community and beyond. Ask God to watch over your family as you bond together to help the women and children in need.
- Mission and church planting ministries in the St. Louis area, including our own Jim Breeden who leads the St. Louis Metro Baptist Association.
- Genesis to be a place where followers of Jesus grow as missionaries to their culture and community.

Yield your prayers and time to someone in need. Look inside your heart and trust God to guide you to a child or widow that could benefit from your assistance.

Wednesday, May 27

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

John 1:1

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.

Praise God all the days of your life.

Repent each day for not staying focused on the reality of the cross

Ask - Pray for:

- God to give you an eternal mind-set, that you will live for things that are eternal.
- Firemen, and others working in service ministries in our area.
- Our Sunday morning worship ministry

Yield by yearning for wisdom and faith in the hard-core fact that God created all. Trust Him.

Thursday, May 28...Last Day of School

Repent for not being surrendered to the mission of God in your life.

Ask - Pray for:

- God to help you see the need to be more involved in what He is doing in the church and around the world.
- A great summer!
- The finances of Genesis Church, pray for God to meet our needs as a church.

Yield by committing to see yourself as a steward of God's resources and being willing to give as He directs.

Friday, May 29

John 6: 54-55

Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him.

Praise Christ for His life, Praise God for giving His only son and Praise the Holy Spirit for living in you. Tell Him how filled your heart is with love for Him.

Repent. Plunge to the lowest point you can find and offer your sins to The Lord, pleading forgiveness with remorse.

Ask - Pray for:

- Those in our culture suffering from divorce and broken homes.
- Genesis Kids Clubs coming up in a couple months.

Saturday, May 30

Hebrews 13:18

Pray for us, for we are sure that we have a clear conscience, desiring to act honorably in all things.

Praise God for being holy, just, and righteous.

Repent...a day of honesty! You know what you need cleansed of! Also, include if you have had feelings that men and women who serve a church need to be flawless...nobody is, nobody will be...Christ Alone!

Ask - Pray for:

- God to lead you into a deeper love relationship with Himself.
