This morning we will be participating in a celebration that was given by Jesus to His followers, and passed on to us. This symbolic meal is called the Lord's Supper or Communion, and was given by Jesus as a reminder of the incredible price that He paid when He died on the cross for us. There is nothing magical in the bread or the juice, but they are images of the body of Jesus that was broken by the nails that put Him on the cross and the blood that He shed for our rebellion. This celebration was given to people who have repented of their sin and trusted in Jesus for their redemption and salvation, and are actively involved in His church and mission. If you have not trusted in Jesus, we would encourage you to spend this time to consider what Christ has done and place your faith in Him. If you have children in the room who have not trusted in Jesus, that is fine. Use this time as a teaching moment.
