Gifted, Part 5 – Charismatic with a Seatbelt

1 Corinthians 14:1-12

Our Fears

- Fear of it getting weird
- Fear of the false and the fake
- Fear of being known
- Fear of falling into heresy
- Fear of it getting weird

Two gifts that represent the current voice of the Spirit and how we should respond to them.

I. Speaking in tongues

Speaking in tongues is Spirit empowered prayer or praise spoken in syllables not understood by the speaker.

Acts 2:1-7

The Coming of the Holy Spirit

[1] When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. [2] And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. [3] And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. [4] And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

[5] Now there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven. [6] And at this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one was hearing them speak in his own language. [7] And they were amazed and astonished, saying, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? (ESV)

Purposes for Tongues

- 1. Communicate truths of God in languages unknown
- 2. A form of prophetic word, when coupled with interpretation
- 3. A private language of prayer for the individual

Speaking in tongues is a gift that drives the present voice of the Holy Spirit deep, forming individuals who are deeply in tune to the Spirit and His working.

II. Prophecy

The Spirit empowered telling something that God has spontaneously brought to mind.

What prophecy is not

- Preaching
- Counseling
- Divine authority

What prophecy is

- The voice of the Spirit speaking through individuals to individuals and the church
- The voice of the Spirit at times in our preachers and teachers speaking in spontaneous ways through them.
- Proclamation and prediction

1 Thessalonians 5:20-22

[20] Do not despise prophecies, [21] but test everything; hold fast what is good. [22] Abstain from every form of evil. (ESV)

Prophecy is a gift that drives the present voice of the Holy Spirit wide, forming individuals who hear the voice of God as it applies to our lives in the present, pointing out sin and revealing God's glory and presence in the now.
